Hotel Reservations

Hotel room rates apply from Friday, March 5 through Tuesday, March 16, 2010, if rooms are available. Convention attendees are invited to extend their stay.

Hotel Transportation

The hotel is 18 miles from Dallas/Fort Worth International Airport (DFW). Standard airport shuttle charges are \$19 one-way and standard taxi charge is \$45 one-way. Love Field Airport (DAL) is 12 miles from the hotel. Shuttle pricing will be posted following a rate revision; however, a one-way taxi charge is \$25. Parking at the hotel is free to paid guests in the outdoor lot or \$10 per exit for indoor parking. The Amtrak train station is 14 miles from the hotel and taxi fee is \$35.

Convention Dress

At nearly every convention, some attendees feel out of place because they were not told what to wear or did not pack enough "convention clothes." Most NBS convention attendees understand the significance of presenting a good impression to the professionals they will be meeting. For most sessions, the accepted dress level is professional attire. Some sessions are "professional casual" attire. Bring comfortable clothes for evening and informal activities.
